Child and Youth Mental Health

Therapy for mental health challenges such as depression, anxiety, trauma, and/or psychosis. Walk-in intake clinics: Castlegar: Tuesdays, 9am-11am; Nelson: Tues & Thurs, 9am-11am; Trail: Thurs, 1pm-3pm

Freedom Quest

Mental health and substance use services for youth.

Castlegar & District Community Services Society

A wide range of programs from long-term counselling to short term groups. Includes youth action network, women's center, affordable housing project, family support counselling, victim support, violence counselling and more.

Nelson Community Services

Child and youth community mental health program, outreach, and counselling. Youth support services available through Cicada Place and shelter support services at Aimee Beaulie Transition House.

ARC Programs

Intervention, treatment and rehabilitative services to children, youth and families. Programs include West Kootenay Child-in-Care Wraparound Support program, youth support family advancement services, skills acquisition program and more.

Circle of Indigenous Nations - COINS

Mental health and addictions programming for ages 15 to Elder, including one-to-one support as well as group support in a cultural setting and recovery circles.

Trail FAIR Society

Children Who Witness Abuse, counselling services, Sexual Abuse Intervention (SAIP), StrongStart, early childhood and family support, crisis services etc.

North Kootenay Lake Community Services Society

Children and Youth counselling, assessment and therapeutic interventions for children who have emotional, mental and behavioral issues.
