We're looking for a youth-friendly, reliable, and creative person (ages 15–25 preferred) to support project workshops, community events, and outreach efforts. The work is flexible, with some weeks busier than others, and will not exceed 102 hours total over the term.

This is a great opportunity for someone passionate about youth, creativity, and making a difference in their community.

- Support creative workshops with youth aged 9–13
- Help set up and take down materials and event spaces
- Connect with kids and families in a friendly, respectful way
- Assist in organizing pop-up events and community showcases
